


Dr. M. Foscue Brock's dedication to healing made a positive impression on all who were lucky enough to know him.



In the 1930s, Dr. M. Foscue Brock began working for our community. The North Carolina native took on the challenge of caring for some of the region's most gravely ill

patients at Norfolk's Grandy Sanitorium and the Henry A. Wise Hospital for Contagious Diseases. He battled conditions such as tuberculosis and polio without the help of modern antibiotics, vaccines or even penicillin. Now, the family is honoring Dr. Brock's legacy with a \$3 million gift that will establish the M. Foscue Brock Institute for Community and Global Health at EVMS — a program
